It is encouraging to see the numbers at Calvary Place continuing to improve. Please note the following:

Resident Cases

Total – 19

Active – 0

Total Recovered – 18 (one deceased)

No swabs pending

Staff Cases

Total – 26

Active – 1

Total Recovered – 25

No swabs pending

We are hoping that within the next two weeks, pending no further COVID cases, that we can declare our outbreak as officially over. In the meantime, we continue to monitor all residents closely for any signs and symptoms of COVID activity.

As you may have heard on the news, there will be changes occurring in regards to loosening restrictions in the community. At this time, I do not know how these changes will affect us. Please be aware that often times changes that occur within the community setting may be different for health care, and a phased in approach may occur. I ask that you please be patient as we navigate these any changes that will occur. Once I have more information, I will pass this on to you.

It is interesting to look back as to how much things have changed in the past two years. Back on February 26, 2020, I sent an email to staff indicating that due to the current global situation in regards to the Coronavirus, a number of medical supplies are in high demand and request was made to use these items sparingly. Then came the lockdown on March 17, 2020; commencement of in-room visits on August 10, 2020; our first COVID-19 positive case exposure on September 30, 2020; our Indoor Visitation Rooms opening on February 18, 2021; then to the availability of the COVID-19 vaccinations and testing. I cannot say enough about the staff at Calvary Place

and how hard they have worked the past two years. It has not been an easy task and it had its challenges; however, they continue to do their best. I am proud of each and every one of them!!
